DESCRIPTION

#901 Clear Rock Binder is a water based, clear, vinyl acrylic coating. It is formulated with tough acrylic resins, to form a long lasting clear binder on gravel roofs or anywhere loose gravel is present. When applied properly it will secure loose gravel, preventing bare spots, membrane burnouts and loose gravel in gutters and on the ground. It will also enhance the color of the gravel. It may also be used as a sealer and water repellent on masonry and plaster surfaces.

PREPARATION

Surface must be dry and free of dirt, dust, oil, grease, wax, rust, chalky or loose paint, mildew and any other surface contamination that may inhibit adhesion. Repair any splits or holes using proper sealing compound and replace gravel.

APPLICATION

Using brush or spray equipment, apply to the properly prepared surface at the rate of 1½ to 2 gallons per 100 square foot. Garden type tank sprayers may be used for the application of #901 Clear Rock Binder. Coat gravel evenly in one light application. Additional applications may be applied if desired. Do not apply too heavily on sloped roofs, coating may pool and run off. Coating performs best if applied on warm sunny day and should be applied early enough to allow complete drying before sundown. Coating is milky white when wet and dries clear.

Wet material and all tools and equipment may be cleaned with water. Rinse tools and equipment with water before using. Mix thoroughly before using. Do not dilute.

PRECAUTIONS: Do not apply **#901 Clear Rock Binder** when surface or air temperature is below 65° F, or if cold weather, rain or fog is expected within twenty-four hours of application. **#901 Clear Rock Binder** cures through dehydration. Drying time may vary depending upon wet film thickness, temperature, humidity and air movement.

READ AND FOLLOW DIRECTIONS CAREFULLY. REFER TO MSDS FOR PROPER HANDLING. NOT DOT REGULATED. STORE CONTAINERS IN COOL, DRY, PROTECTED AREA. KEEP FROM FREEZING
